Preliminary Options

Develop 2-3 preliminary campus plan concepts with options for:

- Existing building use
- Long-term program distribution
- Campus boundary/expansion
- Building location, massing & scale
- CEQA initial consultation

- Open space and amenities
- Circulation and parking
- Pedestrian networks
- Campus edges and connections
- CPDC (CO) Presentation





Preferred Option

- Identify the single preferred campus plan
- · Develop details, including
 - Utilities infrastructure
 - · Building concept plans
 - Transportation plan
- Coordinate Environmental Project Review (EIR)
- Conduct review meetings with campus stakeholders
- Continue CEQA consultation
- CPDC (CO) Update





Draft & Final

- Unveil a first-draft Campus Master Plan
- Solicit campus-wide feedback
- Present a second-draft Campus Master Plan
- Open final campus-wide review period
- Finalize Campus Master Plan for submission to Chancellor's Office
- Obtain CEQA certification
- Obtain CSU Board of Trustees Approval
